Student Accident Insurance

Providing safe learning environments is a strong and constant focus at the Durham District School Board. Families should however recognize that there is always a potential risk of injury with field trips, sports and other student activities both on and off school grounds. Accidents can happen, despite precautions to prevent them. Accidental injuries may involve medical, dental or other expenses not covered by provincial health care or employer group plans.

STUDENT VERIFICATION FORM

It is time to complete your child's Student Verification Form. Any families who have yet to complete their child's Student Verification Form through the Parent Portal will receive a paper copy of the form this week. If you receive a hard copy, please review, make any updates and sign all waivers directly on the form by pen.

Forms can be returned in your student's backpack. These forms ensure the school has accurate information on file annually regarding all students. Thank you in advance for supporting this annual process.

DSTS is responsible to ensure that all material transported in a school bus does not interfere with the safety of the driver and passengers or the safe expedient evacuation of the vehicle. In the event of an accident such as a rollover or sudden deceleration, objects that are not stored properly can become projectiles causing additional injuries to occupants.

Musical Instruments:

The only musical instruments that should be on the bus are instruments that are small in size, housed in a case and can fit in the student's backpack or safely under part of a seat. Large musical instruments such as guitars, tubas, saxophones, French horns, snare drums and baritones are prohibited on the school bus. Smaller instruments such as flutes or clarinets for example can be stored safely with the student on board the bus.

SUBWAY AND PIZZA LUNCHES

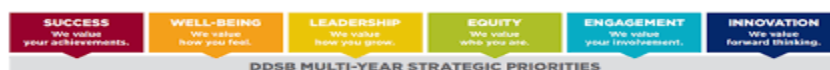
We are in the process of organizing our Subway and Pizza lunches for October. All orders will be placed using Cash Online on a weekly basis. Further details will be forthcoming.

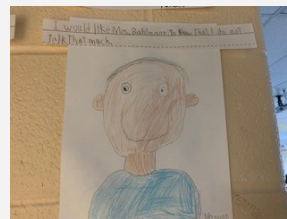
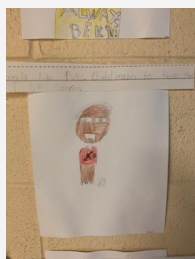

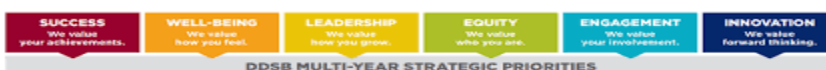
