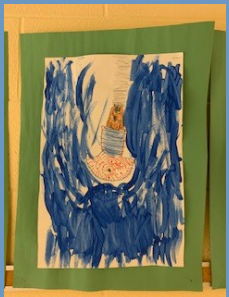
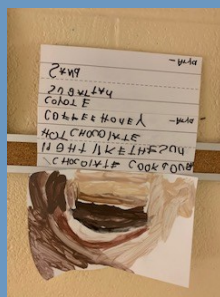
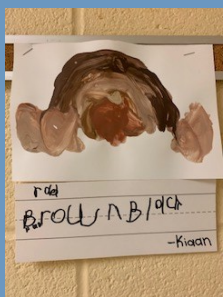

Parents ask the experts


Join us for a Virtual Expert Panel

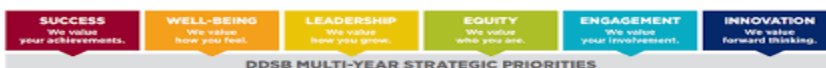
