RealTime and FlexTime

RealTime or Synchronous Learning: refers to all types of learning in which learner(s) and instructor(s) are in the same place, at the same time, in order for learning to take place. This includes in-person classes, live online meetings when the whole class or smaller groups get together.

FlexTime or Asynchronous Learning: occurs through online channels without real-time interaction. This means that learning can occur in different times and spaces particular to each learner. With FlexTime learning, teachers usually set up learning activities which students complete on their own and at their own pace.

Message to Families Re Government of Ontario Support for Learners Funding

Government of Ontario Support for Learners

The Ontario Government is offering parents/guardians the opportunity to apply for a one-time payment to help offset costs due to COVID-19 during the 2020-21 school year. Eligible parents or guardians will receive a one-time payment of:

\$200 for each child/youth up to Grade 12* (including students who are in secondary school that are over 18)

\$250 for each child/youth up to age 21 with special needs

*Please note: Originally, the \$200 was only available for each child up to the age of 12. However, beginning January 11, 2021 Support for Learners is expanding to include students ages 13 to Grade 12, including students who are in secondary school that are over 18.

The deadline to apply is Monday, February 8, 2021.
