Last week in the Southwood P.S. area, it was reported that a stranger had a concerning interaction with one of their students who was walking home from school on Lambard Street.

This is an opportune time to review general safety tips with your children. To assist you, we have compiled a list of safety guidelines for you to discuss with your student now, and at any time of year. Staff, students and parents work and communicate together to make a difference for our learning environment. Our communication continues to be the key to our success. Please discuss the following suggestions with your family so that safe strategies are reinforced:

Safety Guidelines:

- Always walk with a buddy to and from school
- Do not talk to or approach strangers
- Never get into a car/vehicle with a stranger
- Inform your parents and the school if a stranger approaches you
- Always let your parents know if there has been a change in your plans
- Avoid taking shortcuts through fields and parks
- Never walk alone, especially at night
- Be aware of your surroundings when wearing earphones
- It is okay for children not to speak to adults who they do not know

Please take a moment to review these tips with your child. Together we can keep our school and community a safe environment for our children.
