

CLASS PLACEMENTS FOR 2022-2023

The process of school planning and organization for 2022-2023 has started. Projected student enrollments and staffing allocations have been provided by the Durham District School Board to each school. In the upcoming weeks, staff will meet to decide next year's classroom placements for students. In doing so, a wide variety of factors are taken in to consideration ranging from academic strengths to social skills, from work habits to balances of boys and girls, from learning styles to class size, as well as Ministry and Board criteria.

Parents are welcome to provide input into this process by contributing additional information about their children (i.e., special circumstances we may not be aware of or special needs that may affect placement next year). While parental input will be considered, final decisions on student placement rest with the Principal, together with the staff, in meeting the needs of all our students. No assurances can be made regarding class placement for specific students.

Parents wishing to have input are to write to Mrs. Pipher-Hogg (susan.pipherhogg@ddsb.ca) no later than Thursday, May 26th. Our goal is to provide the optimum placement for every child in order to maximize learning for all.
