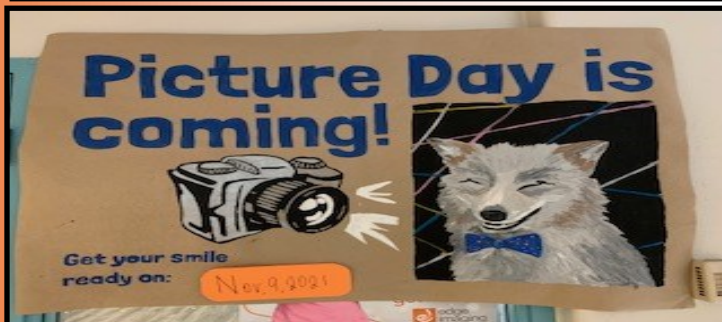

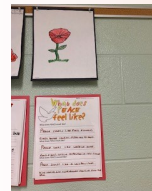


DISRUPTION OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

Progress Reports will be sent out electronically on Wednesday, November 10th

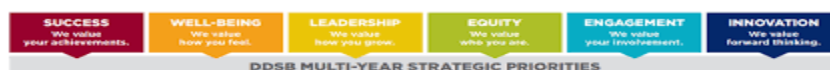
