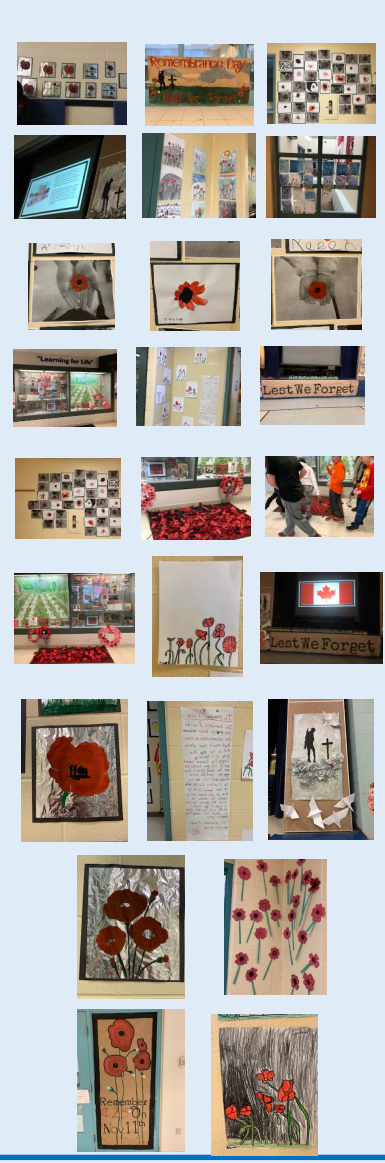
**SchoolCashOnline**


**REMEMBRANCE DAY**
